Dogs must be comfortable on all agility equipment at full height and ready to compete at the Novice through Excellent levels. Working dogs will be divided into two groups of 6, based on skill level, and each group will have working time with both Dudley and Greg. The seminar topics will be tailored to the needs of the working teams. Those registered with working dogs will complete a questionnaire where they can describe the topics that they would like to have presented. Topics can include crosses (front, rear, blind), distance handling, motivation, speed, options for contact training, weave poles, serpentine, 270's, obstacle discrimination, jumping skills, how to shave seconds off your course time, planning course strategy, etc.

Dudley and Greg both have more than a dozen years of experience sharing their lives with and training various breeds of dogs including Cocker Spaniels, Poodles, Labrador Retrievers, and Border Collies.

The Fontaine's have had more than their share of competitive good fortune.

Dudley and her Poodles Bleu, Shay, and Keen all earned AKC Master Agility and Jumpers titles. Shay competed at the 2000 AKC Agility Nationals. Bleu and Keen competed at the Purina Incredible Outdoor Challenge in 2002 & 2003.

Greg and his Labrador Retriever Ivan were USDAA Grand Prix National Finalists in 2000 & 2001. Ivan was the top AKC agility Labrador Retriever for 2001 & 2003. They were invited to compete at the 2002 Purina Incredible Dog Challenge. Ivan has earned his AKC Master Agility Champion and USDAA Agility Dog Champion titles.

Dudley and Greg both have trained and run their Border Collie Maverick. Greg and Maverick won the 2007 USDAA Southeast Regional Jumpers class. Dudley and Maverick won the 2008 USDAA Southeast Regional Steeplechase and the 2009 USDAA Southeast Regional Jumpers and Grand Prix classes. They were USDAA Steeplechase National Finalists in 2008 and finished 4th at the 2009 AKC Agility Nationals. They finished 2nd at the 2009 USDAA Grand Prix National Finals. Maverick has earned his AKC Master Agility Champion and USDAA Agility Dog Champion titles.
