VOLUNTEER WORKER LIST

Many of you have volunteered to help us. Thank you so much! The worker volunteer sheet will be emailed to you on Tuesday or Wednesday of next week after the final move-ups have been processed. It will also be posted on the DOTC web site at www.DOTCLynchburg.org. Let me know if you have any problems with your job assignment. As a volunteer worker, you will get a ticket to the lunch buffet on Saturday or 5 DOTC dollars on Sunday, and also a worker raffle ticket for each hour that you work. See the Ring Managers (Clair Malinowski for JWW and Judy Chang for STD) to get your tickets. DOTC dollars can be used as cash at Louis Pirnik's food concession for breakfast or lunch OR can be saved and applied to entry fees at future agility trials!

If you are local or have a shorter drive home, please consider staying a while to help us move our equipment back into the storage building! The trial should conclude at around 3:30-4 pm on Sunday!

MEASURING & HEIGHT CARDS

Volunteer Measuring Officials Jim and Judy Smotrel can measure your dogs for an official height card. Measuring will be available from 7:15-7:45 AM on Saturday and Sunday, and **additional times throughout the days** whenever they are not running their dogs in Exc STD and JWW 24". If you did not send in a valid height card with your dog's entry (see the check box with your data), you must either present your valid height card at check-in or your dog must be measured before its first run (even 24" dogs). See the trial secretary to pick up your armbands after measuring.

If you sent in a height card, your armbands for the weekend will be provided in envelopes by Handler name at the check-in table. Handlers may check in after 7:15 AM on Saturday or 7:15 AM on Sunday.

SATURDAY LUNCH BUFFET

On Saturday, each ring will shut down for about 20-30 minutes for our free lunch buffet for all exhibitors and workers and prepaid guests. Lou Pirnik will provide pork loin with sauces, pasta salad, green salad, pound cake and ice cream! Ring 1 will break after Exc Std is completed. Ring 2 will break after Nov JWW. Lunch will be served from noon until about 1:15 pm. Please go to the buffet line whenever you are free during this time. Your free Lunch Buffet tickets will also be enclosed in your armband envelope if you indicated that you wanted to join us! A limited number of non-exhibitor tickets will be available at the trial for \$8 each. Check the lunch list (attached and also on web site) to see if your name is included! **Please verify that I have recorded the right choice for you.** If you missed it, email me now! Just let me know what you want – no lunch, regular buffet or just veggies!

We will be running small dogs to big dogs all days.

Within each class and height division, the running order will be: Excellent B, A, BP, AP; Open, Open Pref; Nov B, Nov A, Nov Pref. If you have a ring conflict, the FAST ring will take precedence in the morning, and then your Standard run should take precedence.

On Saturday and Sunday, Excellent Std will begin at 10 am in Ring 1. This is one hour later than stated in the premium list. We expect that the Exc STD course will be built and ready for obsessive walking for all heights by 8:30am!

Ring #2 will begin with Exc FAST each day: briefing and walk through at 7:45 am, judging starts at 8 am.

RVS AND CAMPERS

We have limited room for RV parking at this event on a prepaid basis only. All available spaces are now reserved. Tent camping is allowed on the grassy areas. Please do not drive vehicles on the ball fields! Parking is permitted in the front grassy field near the road, weather permitting.

SETUPS

Exhibitors may setup shade tents ringside on Friday afternoon after the ring gates are in place and the reserved areas have been marked with orange tape (perhaps by 3 pm). Crates can also be setup inside after 3 pm.

AIR CONDITIONED crating is available for all dogs (and people) inside the BRC building. It is a large open room with a concrete floor. There will be tape lines on the floor to mark the walkways. Please cleanup your area when you leave.

VENDORS attending are Beverley Adams (Therapeutic Massage for dogs or people), Dawn Neff (embroidered items), Soucy's Rocket Tunnels (agility equipment) and Louis Pirnik who will provide a food concession at this trial with breakfast and lunch foods. Your DOTC dollars will be accepted at Lou's food concession! Ian and Karen Stewart, Stewart Event Images, and a local photographer Dianna McKinney will take action shots of your dogs – one photographer for each ring. Be sure to visit their booths.

In general, follow the signs to Rt 501 North! Here are the details:

US 460 - From the West of Lynchburg: From 460, take the right-hand exit to 460 E Business (Timberlake Rd). Proceed for about 3 miles. At the junction of Rt 501, exit to the right and follow 501 North for about 2 miles to a traffic light at Rt 221. *Continue straight on Rt 501 N through the light at Rt 221. At the next light, turn left onto Rt 501 North, "NorthWest Expressway". At the next light at Boonsboro Rd, turn left (still 501 N) and go about 2 miles. Turn left onto Coffee Road (Rt 644) and go about 2 miles. The Boonsboro Ruritan Club Building is on your right.*

US 460 - From the East of Lynchburg: Exit Rt 460 at Candler's Mountain Rd (a right turn exit). Follow signs to Rt 501 North (River Ridge Mall will be on your left, and Days Inn will be on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt 501 North/Rt 29. Follow 501 N for about 3 miles to Lakeside Dr, Rt 221. *See italics above.*

US 29 – NEW DIRECTIONS due to new Bypass around Madison Heights!

As you approach Sweet Briar College, stay on Rt 29 Lynchburg/Danville. Do not take Business 29 to Madison Heights unless you want to go through all of that traffic! Don't take the Sweet Briar College exit. As you near Lynchburg, take exit to W 460/S 29 to Lynchburg. Rt 501 N soon joins 460 W. Exit Rt 460 at Candler's Mountain Road/Buena Vista and follow the directions from Rt 460 East above.

US 29 - From the South of Lynchburg: Follow Rt 29 North into the city limits (pass River Ridge mall entrance on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt 501 North and proceed for about 3 miles to Rt 221. *See italics above.*
