Approved Training Equipment includes, but is not limited to:

Leashes: 6 foot cotton web leash is recommended; nylon or leather is acceptable. (No chain leashes)

Longer leash or Flexi-leash is acceptable is some training situations.

Collars: Nylon snap around training collar is recommended, fitting snugly behind the ears.

Acceptable: prong collars, buckle collars, halters like Gentle Leader, Promise, etc.

Questions about approved training equipment should be directed to the Training Director.

Training Rules:

- 1. Clean up after your dog, both inside the training building and outside in the grass. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of training privileges without refund of your training fees.
- 2. Objects of attraction such as food treats, toys, balls may be used in training. Pick up all dropped food treats, and be considerate in your use of toys so that they do not unreasonably distract other dogs being trained.
- 3. Excessively harsh or inhumane verbal or physical corrections are not allowed in the classes. They disrupt the positive training atmosphere for the other dogs in the class.
- 4. Keep your dog on a short leash as you enter and exit the building. Constantly be aware of your dogs interactions with other people and other dogs so that you can prevent problems before they occur.
- 5. Any children not directly involved in the training classes must be under control, away from the training rings and not disruptive to the classes while inside the training building.
