SITE NOTES

- The building opens daily one hour before judging starts.
- Indoors, Temperature controlled, one matted 40x50 ring. The regulation-sized ring (at least 40’x 50’) will be fully matted with DOTC’s interlocking non-slip foam mats and enclosed with ring gates. The position of the ring along the back wall will allow for crating with plenty of room to spread out. Please bring your own chairs.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and themselves in and around the building and parking area.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crating area.

- By submitting an entry to this Event and/or by attending this Event, all exhibitors and attendees agree on behalf of themselves, their agents, their guests, and their minor children that (a) they are personally responsible for their safety and actions during the Event, and (b) they comply with all DOTC policies and rules, including but not limited to any guidelines, signage, and/or instructions. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children, agents, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Dog Owners Training Club of Lynchburg and its agents, members, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Lunch will not be available on site. Please bring your own lunch, snacks and drinks.
- This is a non-smoking building.
- Waiver of Rights – Animals in Distress: The Dog Owners Training Club of Lynchburg reserves the right to remove an animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.
- All persons entering the grounds do so at their own risk. An inherent risk of exposure to communicable diseases exists in any public place. By attending these events, participants voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and any communicable disease related to humans and canines.

ENTRY NOTES

- We are accepting entries for All American Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partner program.
- If you have not received a preliminary confirmation email within 7 days of mailing your entry, please contact tracy@tflservices.com.
- UDX and PUDX will be offered as a class. Dogs entered in the UDX Class will be entered in both Open B and Utility B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either the Open B or the Utility B Class, the UDX Class will be considered closed, and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety. Similarly, for PUDX with Preferred Open and Preferred Utility.
- RACH and RAE will be offered as classes. Dogs entered in the RACH class will be entered in Master, Excellent B, and Advanced B, and the combined entry fees for these three classes must be paid. Dogs entered in the RAE class will be

entered in Excellent B and Advanced B, and the combined entry fees for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached for Rally, the RACH/RAE Class will be considered closed, and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

- Closing date for entries: 6:00 pm, Wednesday, August 26, 2026 at the Trial Secretary's home after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted. Telegraph, emailed, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
- Entries may be made via US Postal Service using entry forms below or generic AKC entry forms.
- Entries made online for a \$5.00 non-refundable service fee per entry form at <https://www.tfletservices.com/dotc-sept-entry-form> or via US Postal Service using entry forms below or generic AKC entry forms.
- Make all checks and money orders payable to: **DOTC**. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. A fee of \$25 will be charged for any returned check.
- Any entry sent via express mail or any other similar service must be sent "no signature required".
- No entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Returned checks, post-dated checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry.
- It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form. In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date.
- By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program. Transfers must be submitted at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial for which the transfer is being requested. Transfers will also be accepted in advance until Tuesday, September 9 at 5:00 pm at tracy@tfletservices.com, please send from the email address submitted on the entry form and include the dog's AKC number, classes being transferred

from, classes being transferred to, jump height if applicable, and trial(s) applicable to transfer.

- A **wait list** will be maintained in accordance with Obedience Regulations Ch 1 Sec. 27 and Rally Regulations Ch 1 Sec. 24 to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn before 6:00 pm EDT, Wednesday August 26, 2026.

REFUND NOTES

- Bitches in season: Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience nor rally trials. The club will refund all but \$5.00 per trial entered for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated letter, signed by your veterinarian stating that your dog is in season. The Trial Secretary must be notified by email or by hard-copy letter no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. Phone calls, texts, and oral communications will not be considered.
- Injured dogs: The club will refund all but \$5.00 per trial entered for injured dogs that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated letter, signed by your veterinarian stating your dog's injury. The Trial Secretary must be notified by email or by hard-copy letter no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. Phone calls, texts, and oral communications will not be considered.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of fees if the error is less than \$10.

- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. Owners and Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. There will be closed-circuit television in the Annex along with check-in charts that should provide adequate information on the armband number of the team being judged.

In general, follow the signs to Rt. 501 North. Here are the details:

US 460 - From the West of Lynchburg: From 460, take the right-hand exit to 460 E Business (Timberlake Rd). Proceed for about 3 miles to Route 501. Exit onto 501 North and go about 2 miles to a traffic light at Rt. 221.

Continue straight on Rt. 501 N through the light at Rt. 221. At the next light, turn left to stay on Rt. 501 North. At the next light at Boonsboro Rd., turn left (still 501 N) and go about 2 miles. Turn left onto Coffee Road (Rt. 644) [Dollar General Store will be on the left] and go about 2 miles. The Boonsboro Ruritan Club Building is on the right.

US 460 - From the East of Lynchburg: Exit Rt. 460 at Candler's Mountain Rd (a right turn exit). Follow signs to Rt. 501 North (River Ridge Mall will be on your left, and La Quinta Inn will be on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North. Follow 501 N for about 3 miles to Lakeside Dr./Rt.221 See italics above.

US 29 - From the North of Lynchburg: After passing the town of Amherst, stay on Route 29 South. (Do not take Business Rt. 29 South). This is the limited-access Madison Heights Bypass. After crossing the James River, Rt. 29 will join Rt. 460 West. DO NOT take Rt. 501 North Business at Campbell Ave. Continue to Candler's Mountain Rd and follow signs for Rt. 501 North. (River Ridge Mall is on the left, and La Quinta Inn on the right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North. Follow 501 N for about 3 miles to Lakeside Dr./Rt.221. See italics above.

US 29 - From the South of Lynchburg: Follow Business Rt. 29 North into the city limits (pass River Ridge mall entrance on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North and proceed for about 3 miles to Rt. 221. See italics above.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. AGREEMENT
